Terms and Conditions the Full Monte 2009

Definitions

The Full Monte means the event held and organised by the board and made available to enjoy by way of a £3,000 + £500 direct sponsorship donation to the event charity 'teenage cancer trust' to be known as TFM. The client means any participant, driver or guests to the event

1. General Information

You as the participant and driver of the vehicle participating must hold a current and valid driving licence and a valid passport, as the driver you must be over the age of 18 years of age.

The Full Monte 2009 is in no way a race, you must not compete, race, bet in any way regarding the event and happenings in the event. If such is done you will be excluded from the event. Please drive properly and with common courtesy to other drivers on route, this includes members of the public and other participants. All participants are to abide by local laws and regulations at all times, law breaking will result in exclusion from the event. This includes road laws, immigration, and weapon laws. Weapons will not be accepted on the event anyone caught in possession of a weapon will be excluded from the event and a refund will not be given. No illegal substances will be accepted on the event, this includes banned drugs, class A, Class B and Class C drugs, anyone caught in possession will be excluded from the event. You as the driver are responsible for the road worthiness of your car, you car must have a full English MOT, legal tyres and conform to emission regulations. Anyone on the event who is caught racing on the public highways will be excluded from any further participation and all privileges removed. You the driver and Passenger must conduct yourself in an appropriate manner, taking account of hotel rules and instructions given to you on the event. Driving under the influence will result in exclusion from the event; anyone who is violent or abusive during the event will also be excluded. Anyone failing to co-ordinate with the organisers or violate these terms/rules will result in exclusion and no refund will be given. Vehicles must be confirmed by June 1st 2009.

2. Event Information

Entry to the event and therefore your place is granted by the organisers and as the organisers hold the right to refuse your application for entry of which reasons will not have to be given. Entry to the event is granted to the event on the decision of the board, full deposit, completed form and signature of driver, on a first come first served basis. The entry fee (£3000 + £500) does not included personal items such as petrol/diesel (fuel), telephone bills, hotel damages, additional room items such as mini bar items, extra drinks, extra food, and any other costs incurred at hotels or additional venues. This will have to be paid separately by the entrant on departure from the hotel , if this is not complied with you will be invoiced with the amount unpaid on arrival back in the UK with additional fees of 20% of which you are obliged to pay under signing entry to the event. The event board has the final decision in any dispute or discussion.

3. Payment and Cancellation

The standard rights to cancel are observed within a seven day cooling off period from the date of signed acceptance to the event. All deposits paid are non refundable and contract can be cancelled without prejudice upto 60 days prior to the event. A deposit of £1000 GBP is required to hold the participants place on the event, an additional £1000 GBP is then due 60days before the event and a further £1000 GBP is due 30 days before the event totalling £3000 GBP + £500 Direct Sponsorship to TCT by 1st September 2009. If payments are missed

an administration charge of £200 may be added to the owed amount. If either is not paid refusal to the event will be granted without a refund. The board reserve the right to change/postpone the event in any part should such circumstances arise where this is the only option. If it proves necessary for the event to be cancelled a full refund will be issued within 2 weeks of the board's cancellation date or where possible an alternative date provided. In the event of a natural disaster at any point in the event or before the event that prevents the event from going forward, fire, flood, strike and any other acts of nature, civil war, or means out of our control The Full Monte will not be held responsible for a refund of any kind. On commencement of the event The Full Monte is also not liable to provide a refund for anyone who can not continue in the event for any reason whatsoever. If you are unable to make it to a venue provided, then additional accommodation fees incurred by you we are not liable for. If you decide to book a place on the event you will be given a 7 day cooling off period where you are liable for a full refund of the deposit and your place will become invalid. If you wish to cancel your place on the event full written confirmation will be required from the signature on the entry form. Any cancellations received after the 7 day cooling off period are not liable for any refund, if the place cancelled and then filled by entrant additional money will be donated to the Teenage Cancer Trust.

4. Insurance and Liability

All participants in the event are responsible for ensuring that their vehicle is a roadworthy and safe condition, properly licensed and fully insured for use in the all locations being visited. All participants must have at least 3rd party insurance cover. Insurance cover notes will be required. Life insurance, travel insurance, personal injury and any other insurances are not included in the price of the entry fee. It is all participants' responsibility to ensure that they have appropriate breakdown cover for the event as The Full Monte is not responsible for any parts or labour cost incurred on the event. The Full Monte is not responsible for any accident caused by participants and their vehicles during the event; The Full Monte is not responsible for any breach of laws or regulations of any country along the route. Participants shall be held responsible for an accident or breach of any laws/regulations a country may have. The Full Monte hereby declares that it is not responsible for any injuries/death that may occur along the trip you enter the event at your own risk.

5. Promotion

Each entrant will be provided with The Full Monte decals magnetic or vinyl sticker for attachment to cars subject to owners agreement. Stickers are non permanent and can be removed easily without any damage to paintwork. The Full Monte will not accept any claims for damage to paintwork. Personal sponsorship will be accepted. I hereby give my consent to be photographed/filmed along the whole event by The Full Monte itself and by the press. I hereby give my permission for my image to be used after the event for advertising/promotional activities. All footage/photographs remain the possession of The Full Monte after the event.

6. Medical

You may be driving in different weather conditions/climates often for quite long periods of times I hereby on signing this document understand that and accept it. Any medical conditions should be stated in the entry form, if any conditions are considered to affect your health on the event please seek advice from your doctor before entering the event. For the purpose of your quality of enjoyment on the event we need to know relevant medical information this includes: medical conditions e.g. epilepsy, allergic reactions e.t.c

7. Hotels

Hotel/Chateau accommodation is included as part of the £3000 + £500 entry fee and are offered subject to availability. The Full Monte reserves the right to change accommodation if necessary to an equivalent grade venue.

8. Surcharges

We reserve the right to apply surcharges to currency fluctuations or any other circumstances we can not avoid.

9. Travel Documentation

All participants are responsible for ensuring that they have all relevant travel documentation, passports and visas must all be valid.

10. Terms and Conditions and Waiver

All clients release and indemnity TFM from and against, and TFM will not be liable for any claims, demands, actions, suits or proceedings, costs, expense's, losses, damages arising out of or otherwise in connection with the event.

The Full Monte board have the right to change the terms and conditions if necessary subject to notifying you the participant to the changes. You will have been perceived as accepting all of these terms and conditions by participating in the event. By participating in this event I understand all of the documentation stated here. I acknowledge the danger of general road driving, private roads, mountain roads, high altitude, forces of nature. Terrorism, civil unrest, travelling by tunnel, accident or illness all without mean for immediate evacuation and medical facilities. I understand that in the event of personal injury or death to me the participant or any damage to my personal property that I will not bring any actions or any type of proceedings against The Full Monte or any of the board members/employees of the event or anyone associated with the event. I have read all of the above and understand and agree with it fully, I acknowledge that the organisers of the event will make reasonable efforts to ensure that all participants on the event will abide by the above terms and conditions of entry but that the organisers can not guarantee they will be fully complied with. I indemnify The Full Monte, the board of trustees, founders, employees, licensees, partners and sponsors from all claims, demands, or expenses that result of my breaching of these terms and conditions, my negligence or otherwise arising out of my participation in the event. I understand that there are risks in participating in this event and we The Full Monte will use our endeavours to ensure that all participants in the event abide by these terms and conditions but can not guarantee this. The Full Monte, the board of trustees, founders, employees, licensees, partners and sponsors exclude themselves from all liability in relation to your participation in the event and I fully understand this.

The terms and conditions documented for the event are governed by English law, and you submit jurisdiction to the English courts.
